KEEP AT IT!

Two weeks from this Sunday is Palm Sunday and so the beginning of Holy Week. We are over the hump of Lent but still have some time to go.

30 of us filled out a card naming our Lenten discipline. This was in response to the RenewalWorks Team who invited us to become "spiritual leaders of our own faith" by, for the first time, sharing our practice. As I look at the list of practices, all submitted anonymously, I'm struck by the great variety of practices. These include things like fasting from meat, alcohol or chocolate; meditating on death, healing, or gratitude and daily practices like reading, singing and prayer. The reported disciplines are delightfully diverse.

As Lent comes to a close, the RenewalWorks Team will be offering us an opportunity to share our experiences and see if we've learned anything. I am still fasting from internet news and I have felt a great difference in my daily life. I am looking forward to sharing my thoughts with others and hearing what others have learned.

It's not too late to start something if you like. Even now, you can do a small thing as a way to prepare your heart for Holy Week.
