LENT IS HERE AT ST. PAUL'S

Here are 5 ways you can observe Lent this year:

- 1. **Read the Gospel of John** either by yourself or in the 10am Wednesday or 6:20pm Thursday Bible Studies.
- 2. Weekly Midweek Eucharist on Wednesdays at 8am, starting tomorrow, Ash Wednesday.
- 3. Weekly Morning Prayer in the church at 7:30am on Tuesdays.
- 4. Make a Light Fast on Wednesdays and/or Fridays by either skipping dinner or having a very light dinner.
- 5. Pray each morning by saying "O God, send me this day to do the work you have given me to do, to love and serve you with gladness and singleness of heart"- and come Wednesday nights at 7pm to learn the true power of those words.
