THE BAPTISM

Hymn 516

(Procession of Baptismal party to the font)

Celebrant The candidate for Holy Baptism will now be presented.
Parents and Godparents I present Elijah to receive the Sacrament of Baptism.
Celebrant Will you be responsible for seeing that the child you present is brought up in the Christian faith and life?
Parents and Godparents I will, with God's help.
Celebrant Will you by your prayers and witness help this child to grow into the full stature of Christ?
Parents and Godparents I will, with God's help.

Then the Celebrant asks the following questions of the parents and godparents who speak on behalf of the child.

Ouestion Do you renounce Satan and all the spiritual forces of wickedness that rebel against God? Answer I renounce them. *Ouestion* Do you renounce the evil powers of this world which corrupt and destroy the creatures of God? Answer I renounce them. Question Do you renounce all sinful desires that draw you from the love of God? Answer I renounce them. Question Do you turn to Jesus Christ and accept him as your Savior? Answer I do. Question Do you put your whole trust in his grace and love? Answer I do. Question Do you promise to follow and obey him as your Lord? Answer I do. *Celebrant* Will you who witness these vows do all in your power to support them in their life in Christ? People We will. *Celebrant* Let us join with those who are committing themselves to Christ and renew our own baptismal covenant. The Baptismal Covenant Celebrant Do you believe in God the Father? *People* I believe in God, the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth. Celebrant Do you believe in Jesus Christ, the Son of God? People I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord. He was conceived by the power of the Holy Spirit and born of the Virgin Mary. He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried. He descended to the dead. On the third day he rose again. He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again to judge the living and the dead. Celebrant Do you believe in God the Holy Spirit? *People* I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. *Celebrant* Will you continue in the apostles' teaching and fellowship, in the breaking of bread, and in the prayers? People I will, with God's help. Celebrant Will you persevere in resisting evil, and, whenever you fall into sin, repent and return to the Lord? People I will, with God's help. Celebrant Will you proclaim by word and example the Good News of God in Christ? People I will, with God's help. Celebrant Will you seek and serve Christ in all persons, loving your neighbor as yourself? People I will, with God's help. *Celebrant* Will you strive for justice and peace among all people, and respect the dignity of every human being? People I will, with God's help.

Prayers for the Candidates

Celebrant Let us now pray for this child who is to receive the Sacrament of new birth.

Leader Deliver Elijah, O Lord, from the way of sin and death.

People Lord, hear our prayer.

Leader Open his heart to your grace and truth.

Celebrant Let us pray. Heavenly God, we thank youand the gift of joy and wonder in all your works. **Amen.**

Celebrant Elijah, you are sealed by the Holy Spirit in Baptism and marked as Christ's own for ever. Amen.

The baptisand is presented with a baptismal candle lit from the Paschal Candle.

Celebrant Let us welcome the newly baptized.

Celebrant and People We receive you into the household of God. Confess the faith of Christ crucified, proclaim his resurrection, and share with us in his eternal priesthood.
