Consecration Sunday is Today

In the four years that St. Paul's has followed The New Consecration Sunday Stewardship Program we have seen an inspiring increase in parishioner generosity. Our hope in implementing this new approach to annual giving was to encourage generosity while growing our individual spirituality by supporting St. Paul's mission and ministries. Rather than approaching Consecration Sunday as members of a club who pay dues, we encourage you to give unselfishly as an act of discipleship in response to the question "What percentage of my income is God calling me to give to St. Paul's mission and ministries?"

During morning worship on this Consecration Sunday, we will ask you to make a financial commitment to St. Paul's outreach, mission, and education ministries in our community and beyond. Everyone who completes an Estimate of Giving Card on consecration Sunday does so voluntarily.
