### Consecration Sunday is Coming on October 2

In the four years that St. Paul's has followed The New Consecration Sunday Stewardship Program we have seen an inspiring increase in parishioner generosity. Our hope in implementing this new approach to annual giving was to encourage generosity while growing our individual spirituality by supporting St. Paul's mission and ministries. Rather than approaching Consecration Sunday as members of a club who pay dues, we encourage you to give unselfishly as an act of discipleship in response to the question "What percentage of my income is God calling me to give to St. Paul's mission and ministries?"

During morning worship on Consecration Sunday, we will ask you to make a financial commitment to St. Paul's outreach, mission, and education ministries in our community and beyond. Everyone who completes an Estimate of Giving Card on consecration Sunday does so voluntarily. We especially encourage you to attend Consecration Sunday worship if you are strongly opposed to completing a card. The process is completed in such a way as to ensure that no one will feel personal embarrassment should she or he choose not to complete a card.

We will do no home solicitation to ask people to complete cards. During our Consecration Sunday service our guest leader, The Rev. Phil Roundtree, will conduct a brief period of instruction and inspiration, climaxed by members making their commitments confidentially as an act of worship. Our Consecration Sunday team and Vestry members will encourage participation in Consecration Sunday events through weekly announcements. Since follow-up visits will not be made, we will make every effort to inform, inspire, and encourage everyone to attend Consecration Sunday worship.
