### **O** Antiphons

Every year we start our Advent preparations a little earlier than most churches. Starting in mid-November, each Sunday we sing an O Antiphon and put up a banner with an image from that Antiphon. You may know these Antiphons because we sing them in the hymn O Come, O Come Emmanuel. Each of the seven Antiphons features a word or image from the Old Testament that points to Jesus.
